Curriculum and Learning

Our curriculum question for the half term to ignite curiosity and learning will be "How did the Great Fire of London start?" We will be developing our learning of this through the texts: The Great Fire of London (Year 1) and The Baker's Boy and The Great Fire of London (Year 2).





We will be further exploring this question in History by learning about the

facts of The Great Fire of London and in Art by creating a multimedia piece of artwork.

Other curriculum focuses include:

Maths – Year 1 – Fractions, place Value to 100, money and time. Year 2 – Time, mass, capacity and temperature.

Science – Being a Gardener (Plants)

Computing – Technology Around Us

RE – Gospel: What is the Good News Jesus Brings?

PE – Athletics

Home Learning:

Reading
