World Book Day 7th March 2024

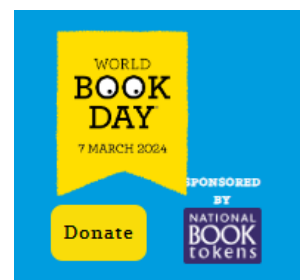
We will be celebrating World Book Day on 7th March 2024 and will be inviting the children to dress up as their favourite book character. However not all children enjoy dressing up.
