Curriculum Information

English:

In English we will be looking at Jim: a cautionary tale by Hillaire Belloc and the BFG by Roald Dahl.

Maths:

In maths we will be looking at Time, Shape and Statistics.

RE:

Our Unit title for RE this half term is 'How do festivals and family life show what matters to Jewish people?'

Science:

Our Science unit will be Plants and their life cycles.

PSHE:

Our PSHE unit will be Growing and Changing.

History:

In History we will be exploring the question 'What did the Ancient Egyptians believe?'

Art:

In Art the children will be continuing to develop their art skills.

Computing:
